Introduction

This case study of Elgin School District U-46 is based on a June 2016 survey of Crisis Prevention Institute customers by TechValidate, a 3rd-party research service.

Challenges

- Sought Nonviolent Crisis Intervention® training to:
 - Reduce workplace violence rate
 - Improve organizational culture
 - Improve staff confidence in working with challenging student behaviors
 - Improve staff skills in managing behaviors

Environment

- Categorizes their school as:
 - An urban school
 - A suburban school

Results

- Reduced challenging / disruptive behaviors by over 50% since implementing CPI de-escalation techniques.
- Agrees that the enhanced content has helped them, their staff, and their school (for example, their trainings are more relevant for more staff, they're able to train more staff such as general education teachers, the staff have more risk assessment skills, the staff have more disengagement skills, and the staff have more skills to reduce restraint use).”
