Please describe how your organization uses Crisis Prevention Institute.

We train school based teams but wish we could provide the de-escalation/ trauma informed approach to ALL educators within the system (not just teachers) BUT due to staff shortages, we could barely have our schoolbased teams trained as it was hard to have release time for a handful of staff.

Would you recommend Crisis Prevention Institute, and if so, why?

Yes. The training has evolved to ensure there is a trauma-informed lens to the work/practice but that component needs to move forward and bring in elements of the impact of systemic racism as well as have to train on engaging in difficult conversations as sometimes behaviours develop because grown adults don't seem to know how to be brave or honest in their work.
