

RANOREX CASE STUDY

Small Business Insurance Company

Introduction

This case study of a small business insurance company is based on a November 2022 survey of Ranorex customers by TechValidate, a 3rd-party research service. The profiled company asked to have their name blinded to protect their confidentiality.

"Simple scripting, SQL data sources, conditions, and identification with automation IDs are just a few ways we use it. Our software is very complex and we have a few different variations of it. Test automation is not possible without the functions mentioned."

"Best of all, it's flexible and offers many possibilities to write tests, a repository for all objects used, etc. And they have good support."

Challenges

The business challenges that led the profiled company to evaluate and ultimately select Ranorex:

- Before using Ranorex, the challenges they had in testing their application:
 - Test coverage: minor challenges
 - Test reporting: average challenges
 - UI object recognition and automation: major challenges
 - Meeting the release schedule or deadline: average challenges
 - Unacceptable amount of bugs in production: minor challenges
 - Getting feedback from testing: minor challenges
